### Inés Rubio

Thursday, 11th August

Inés Rubio is a Catalan flamenco dancer. She trained at the "La Tani" flamenco dance school in Barcelona before being taught in Seville by Farruquito and Carmen Ledesma, among others. At the age of 26 she joined Tarragona's first flamenco company in their show "Tarraconeando". She has worked at some of the best flamenco venues in Spain and has taken part in festivals and contests such as the international contest "Anilla la Gitana" in Ronda (Malaga), where she was awarded the first prize, and she was a semifinalist in the international contest "Cante de las Minas" in La Unión (Murcia). For the last two years she has been teaching in Japan. We will be able to marvel at her artistic talent at the 2nd Olé Vinaròs festival in the Vinaròs Arena.

### Violencheli Brothers

Thursday, 18th August

These two young Valencian violin and cello virtuosos, accompanied by the Pau Chafer Jazz Trio, will take you on a jaw-dropping musical journey from Bach to Michael Jackson, Mozart to Alejandro Sanz, and Vivaldi to Paco de Lucía, playing musical classics with jazz and international pop arrangements.

They were finalists in *Got Talent España 2021* and since then have embarked on a successful tour around Spain: La Rioja, Castilla la Mancha, Extremadura, Valladolid, Toledo and the main auditoriums of the Valencian Community – Alcoi, Sagunt, Palau de la Música de València, etc.

### Dómisol Sisters

Thursday, 25th August

A fun, dynamic concert oozing contagious positive energy and taking the public back in time to the golden age of swing.

Dómisol Sisters formed in 2011 with the aim of bringing 30s and 40s swing music back to life with their own arrangements. The Valencian band launched their first album *Get on Board!* in 2014. Their work was so well received that they went on to launch their second album *Take that Swing!* in 2016. In December 2021 they brought out their first Christmas album, which they named *Xmas in Central Park*. After touring most of the country and performing in numerous theatres, auditoriums and clubs, as well as festivals, the group is now bringing its third project *Smile* to the stage.

### Bárbara Brea

Thursday, 1st September

With an adaptable style that stands out above all for its expression, nuances and connection with the audience, this Valencian singer's repertoire ranges from the most intimate of jazz ballads through to the sassiest of up-tempo tunes. Bringing together bossa nova and blues, and allusions to funk, soul, rock, pop, bolero and South American melodies, this is one long thrill-seeking adventure infused with improvisation.

The singer performs surrounded by renowned Valencian jazz musicians, forming an eclectic group designed to fuse jazz with other musical styles and vice versa in a vibrant concert in which US rhythms (jazz, blues, musicals) are pervaded by Latin airs, Mediterranean aromas and tinges of folk that whisk the audience away on a musical journey with infinite influences.
