



From Vinaròs to the sky: Solar Eclipse Day

On August 12, we'll have the chance to observe from Vinaròs one of the most spectacular astronomical events of the coming years. We suggest two privileged public spaces to enjoy it safely, calmly, and with respect for the environment

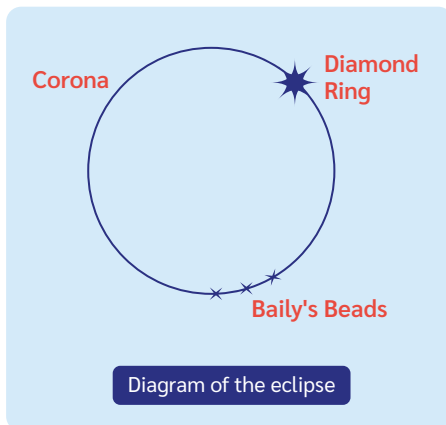

Take precautions

- Enjoy it responsibly
- Observe it safely
- Never look directly at the Sun.

Use only

-  ISO 12312-2 certified glasses, like the ones distributed by Turisme Vinaròs at the Vinaròs Tourist Info
-  Certified solar filters for telescopes or binoculars



How to get your glasses from Turisme Vinaròs

Until August 2: complete Turisme Vinaròs new game, A Postcard Adrift, and get two pairs of glasses per person.

From August 3 to August 12, get one pair of glasses per person in person at the Vinaròs Tourist Info after filling out a short questionnaire.



Scan and play!

During the interval of totality, protective glasses may be removed once the Sun is fully covered by the moon (the totality phase). At that moment it is safe to look at the sky with the naked eye and enjoy the darkness and the solar corona.

As soon as the first solar flash reappears (diamond ring), you must put your glasses back on immediately, otherwise serious and permanent eye damage could occur.

Other recommendations

- Arrive early.
- Bring water.
- Protect yourself from the sun.
- Wear a cap.
- Bring a folding chair if you'd like.
- Set up telescopes clear of the walkway.
- Follow the instructions of municipal staff.

Mobility

- Come on foot
- Come by bike
- Share your vehicle

Parking is only allowed in designated areas. Avoid parking on sidewalks, farm tracks, or emergency access routes.
